These tutored life drawing classes will guide your creativity and explore personal expression and response, rather than focusing on anatomical proportion and traditional interpretation. Therefore the classes are suitable for all abilities as an aid to develop confidence and individual style whilst considering all the formal elements needed to produce a finished piece of art to be proud of.

The first class will look at working with charcoal, exploring its potential and experimenting with different styles and processes. The class will offer the chance to work in both line and tone with reflection and tutoring given during poses. The second class will focus on the medium of graphite and mark-making techniques. By the end of each class you can expect to take home a collection of quick figure studies and at least 3 more sustained drawings.

Morris aims to present a contemporary feel to life drawing through his imaginative styling, composition and consideration of the figure. In each class surreal or stylised scenes are created to inspire.
